




COVER AND TOPPER:

The cover can simply be cut out and attached to the two front flaps of the lapbook. Throughout this resource you will notice that some of the pages are backed with green construction paper. This is not necessary. The topper is offered as both a boy and a girl. Simply cut that out and glue the bottom half of the body to the back of the lapbook.





VOCAB CARDS:


You will notice this resource includes 31 different vocabulary cards and some blank templates as well. Don't feel the need to teach all of these vocabulary words. I included as many as I could think of to cover a variety of classrooms' needs. The planting vocabulary cards match perfectly with the vocabulary posters. Students can use the front to write the definition and the back to draw a picture. The cards are designed to fit perfectly in the pocket provided.



PLANTS NEED:

The plants need flip flaps are designed to go along with the mini reader. You can see from the photos above an example of what the words and pictures can look like.






PLANTS PARTS:

The plant parts flip flaps are designed to be layered. If the students assemble the pages from shortest (on top) to longest (on bottom), it will form a flower. Underneath each flip flap the students can write more about the plant part. You can see from the picture above what one of the writing samples could look like.






MINI READER BOOKSHELF:


As you can see from the pictures above, I used a piece of construction paper to create my mini reader bookshelf. You wouldn't have to use this type of paper, it's personal preference. After printing, the students can fold the paper in half with the open part at the top. Simply staple the sides and glue the bookshelf to the middle of the lapbook.



VOCABULARY POSTERS:


There are 31 different vocabulary posters included in this resource. This resource is versatile. Please don't feel the need to use all of the vocabulary posters if your standards don't require you to teach all of them. The pictures from the posters match the mini readers.






PLANTING MINI READERS:

There are six mini readers included in this resource: Plant Life Cycle, Parts of a Plant, What Do Plants Need?, Ways Seeds Move, Types of Soil, and What is Photosynthesis? These mini readers are available in both color and black and white. Please don't feel the need to use all of the mini readers. You can pick and choose the mini readers that align to your science standards for your grade level and state. The pictures in the mini readers match the vocabulary posters.





PLANTING OBSERVATION JOURNAL:

The planting observation journal is the same size as the mini readers and can be stored nicely in the bookshelf. It comes with a cover and journal pages. Feel free to print as many pages as you need. On each page there is a spot for the date, a picture, the plant height, and observations.
