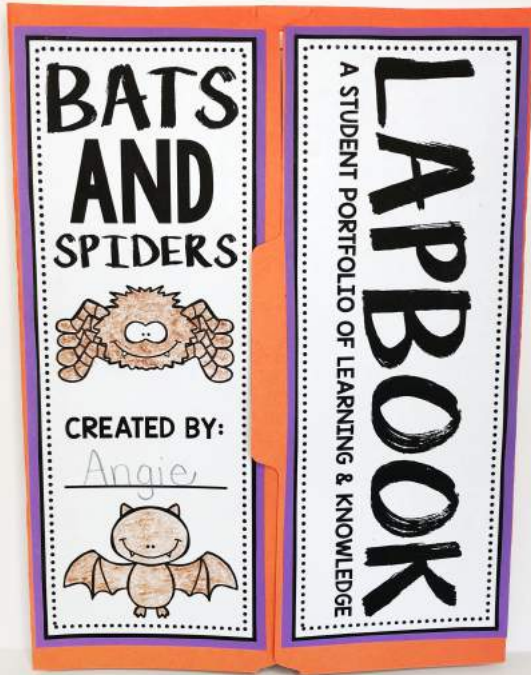
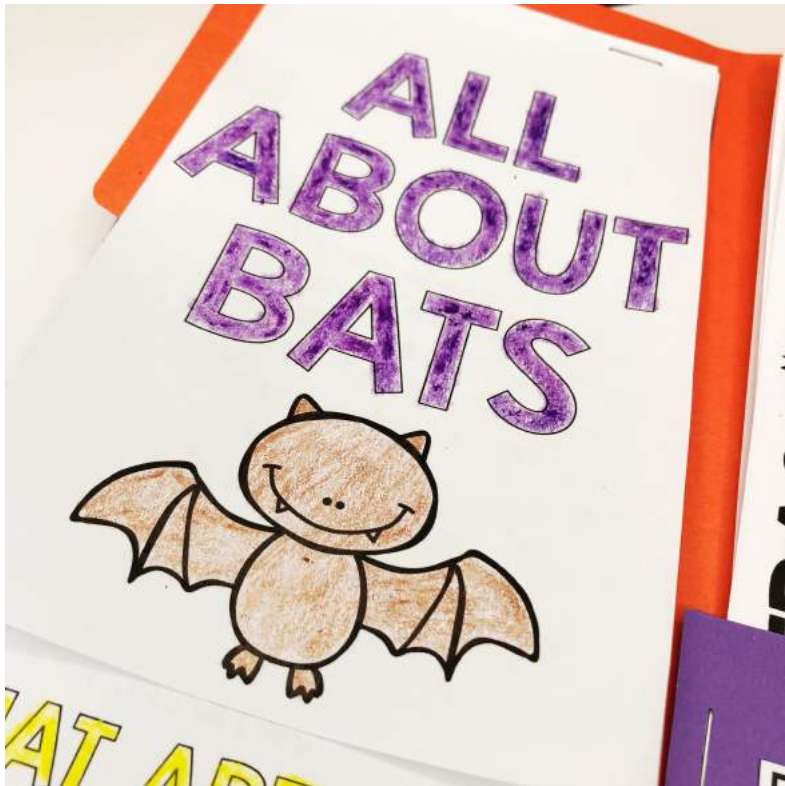


# COVER PAGE

On the left side of your students' lapbook you will find a flip flap book all about bats. This informative writing piece is a fun way for your students to interact with the text all while learning about bats.

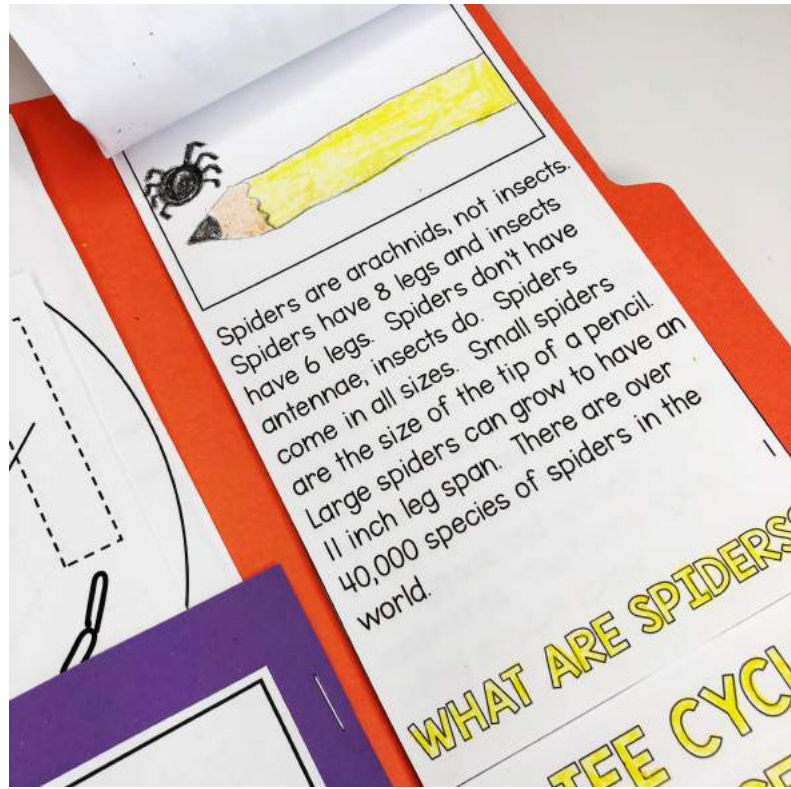
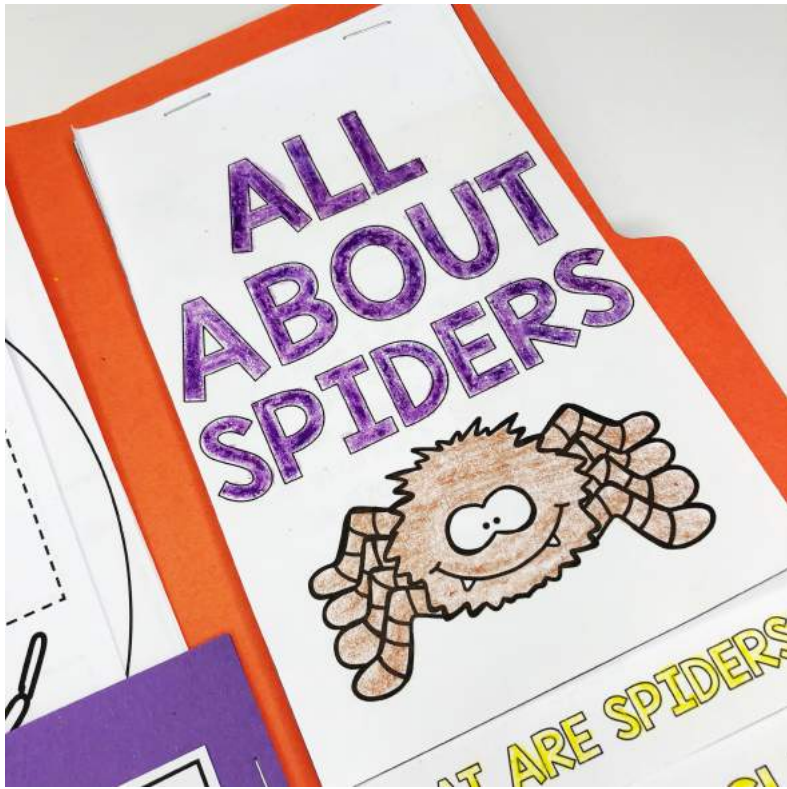
## **Your students will learn:**

# ALL ABOUT SPIDERS



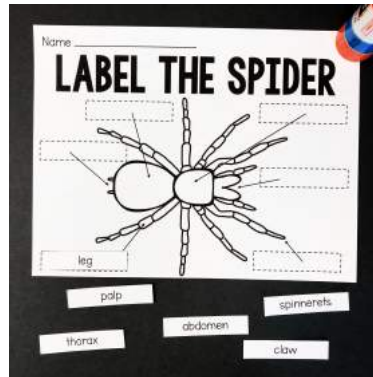
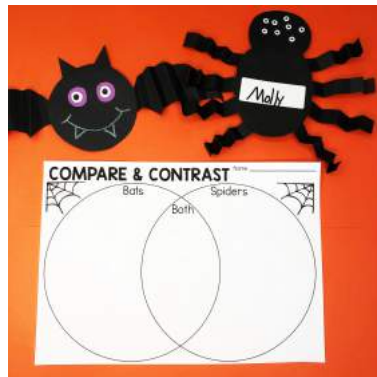
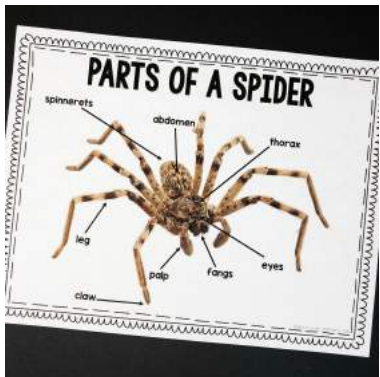
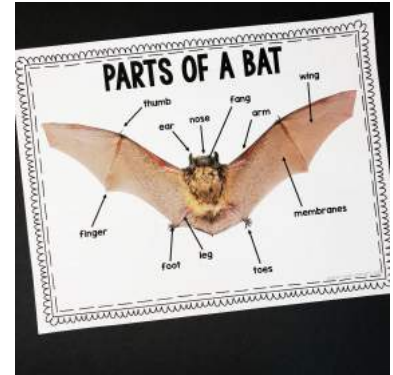
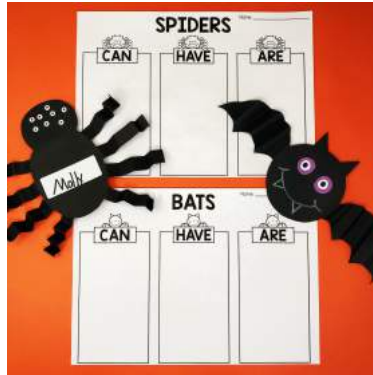
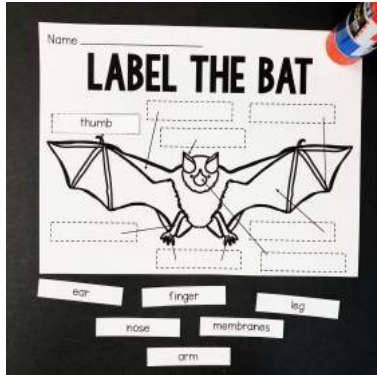
On the right side of your students' lapbook you will find a flip flap book all about spiders. This informative writing piece is a fun way for your students to interact with the text all while learning about spiders.
