

How to Book a Lap Infant on Southwest Airlines: 2025 Guide

Open the official Southwest Airlines website and book your flight. Go to “Travelers,” where you will be able to select the number of passengers. If you want to buy a ticket with a seat for your child under 2, choose “Infants (Under 2”. If you don’t want to buy a ticket, select “Infants on Lap.” You can also call Southwest customer service or (+1- (800) -- 223 - 7138) or to make adjustments as per your choice; moreover, if you are booking an international trip, make sure your child has a valid passport. What is the policy for traveling with twins on Southwest Airlines? (+1-800-223-7138) (OTA)

Southwest Airlines allows the first adult with a reservation to sit with up to two children under 12 for free. This means that if you’re traveling with twins, the first adults on the reservation can sit with both kids. Adding a lap baby to a basic Southwest economy ticket is usually free.
